### Definitions

- "Number of Students Who Began Program" means the number of students who began the program who are scheduled to complete the program within 100% of the published program length within the reporting calendar year, and excludes all the students who cancelled during the cancellation period.
- "Students Available for Graduation" is the number of students who began program minus the number of students who have died, been incarcerated, or been called to active military duty.
- "Number of On-Time Graduates" is the number of student who completed the program within 100% of the program length.
- "On-Time Completion Rate" is the number of on-time graduated divided by the Number of Students Available for Graduation.
- "150% Graduates" is the number of students who completed within 150% of the program length (includes on-time graduates)

- "150% Completion Rate" is the number of students who completed the program in the reported calendar year within 150% of the published program length, including on-time graduates, divided by the Number of Students Available for Graduation.
- "Graduates Available for Employment" means the number of graduates minus the number of graduates unavailable for employment.
- "Graduates unavailable for employment" means the graduates who, after graduation, die, become incarcerated, are called to active military duty, are international students that leave the United States or do not have a visa allowing employment in the United States, or are continuing their education in an accredited or bureau-approved postsecondary institution.
- "Graduates Employed in the Field" means graduates who beginning within six months after a student completes the applicable educational program are gainfully employed, whose employment has been reported, and for whom the institution has documented verification of employment. For occupations for which the state requires passing an examination, the six months period begins after the announcement of the examination results for the first examination available after a student completes an applicable educational program.
- "Placement Rate Employed in the Field" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates gainfully employed in the field by the number of graduates available for employment.
- "Number of Students Taking Exam" is the number of graduates who took the first available exam in the reported calendar year.
- "First Available Exam Date" is the date for the first available exam after the students completed the program.
- "Passage Rate" is calculated by dividing the number of graduates who passed the exam by the number of graduates who took the reported licensing exam.
- "Number who Passed First Available Exam" is the number of graduates who took and passed the first available licensing exam after completing the program.
- "Salary" is as reported by the graduate or graduates employer
- "No Salary Information Reported" is the number of graduates for whom, after making reasonable attempts, the school was not able to obtain salary information.

## STUDENTS RIGHT TO CANCEL

### General Policy Considerations

- ☐ This policy applies to all terminations for any reason, by either party, including student decision, student expulsion, course or program cancellation, or school closure.
- ☐ The student has the right to cancel the enrollment agreement and obtain a refund of 100% of the charges paid (less the non-refundable application fee of \$100) through attendance at the first class session, or the seventh day after enrollment, whichever is later.
- ☐ Cancellation shall occur when a student gives written notice of cancellation to the School by mail or hand delivery. The written notice of cancellation is effective when received by the School. Written cancellation should be sent to: TheCosmoFactory Cosmetology Academy, Attn: Admissions, 131-B Front Street, Santa Cruz, CA 95060. The written notice of cancellation need not take any particular form and, however expressed, it is effective if it shows that you, (the student), no longer wish to be bound by this Enrollment Agreement.
- ☐ A student may be expelled from the school for reasons of conduct, not returning from an approved Leave of Absence or for not maintaining SAP for 2 or more consecutive evaluation periods.
- ☐ The **formal cancellation date** will be determined by the postmark on the written notification (see above), the date said notification is delivered to the school in person, the date of expulsion by the school, or 30 days after the last day of attendance or the expiration date of an **approved** Leave of Absence. An **unofficial withdrawal** occurs by monitoring the clock hours and daily attendance. The formal of cancellation date is determined via the last date of student attendance.
- ☐ Any monies due the applicant or student shall be refunded within 45 days of formal cancellation date as defined above. TheCosmoFactory Cosmetology Academy will mail the refund to the students address on the Enrollment Agreement, unless otherwise noted.
- ☐ If permanently closed or no longer offering instruction after a student has enrolled, the school will provide a full refund of all monies paid or completion of the course at a later time. The school does not participate in any teach-out plans with other institutions.
